## STORM WATER AND FLOODING TECHNOLOGY PILOT

Hurononia has teamed up with one of its longtime Customers, [Greenland Consulting](#), to study [storm water and flooding as part of a technology pilot](#) project in Collingwood. The pilot project will also draw on the expertise of the [Environment Network](#) and Safe Pump Inc.

Once funding has been approved, the project would install sump pump monitors in select homes in Collingwood. These monitors would then be connected to the internet and provide real-time monitoring of sump pump battery life and will also send out an alert to the homeowner when the power goes out in their home. This project will monitor the ongoing benefits of these types of technologies in the community and their effectiveness in bettering flood resiliency.

Hurononia's involvement in this preliminary stage of the project will be to monitor the data and the sump pumps.
