Then press 1 for false alarms or 2 to put the system on test. Have your Account Number or your service address (with accurate spelling of the street name) ready, along with your passcode to validate you as a user.

For Monitoring Account Changes: If you need to make changes to your monitoring account, update passcodes / passwords, call down lists, vacation notices, etc., please continue to email monitoring@huronialarms.com and one of Huronia Alarm's Customer Service reps will be able to assist you.

PLEASE NOTE: Calls from the monitoring station will show on your call display as **705.527.9311** (same as before). Burglary text messages will show on your call display as **587.609.5874 (new service)**.
