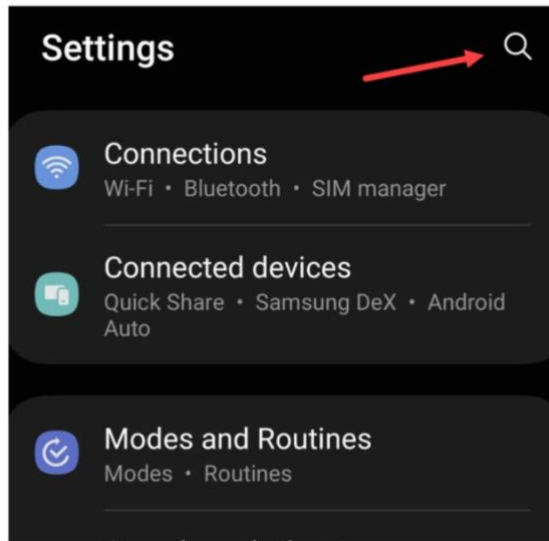

UPDATE FROM OPP: HELP REDUCE INCIDENTS OF 911 HANG-UPS ON ANDROID PHONES

The Ontario Provincial Police have seen a significant increase in 911 hang-ups recently. This may be linked to an Android update which turned on Emergency SOS. The Emergency SOS feature on Android phones automatically calls 911 after the side button key is pressed five times in a row. After a 911 call is made, a police dispatcher must determine that the caller is safe and that there is not a true emergency. This new update makes it easier to accidentally dial 911 without knowing. Please, check your phone, and if

you did not turn the emergency SOS feature on intentionally, consider turning it off to ensure 911 lines are available for life-threatening emergencies.

Step 2 – Locate Emergency SOS and turn it off

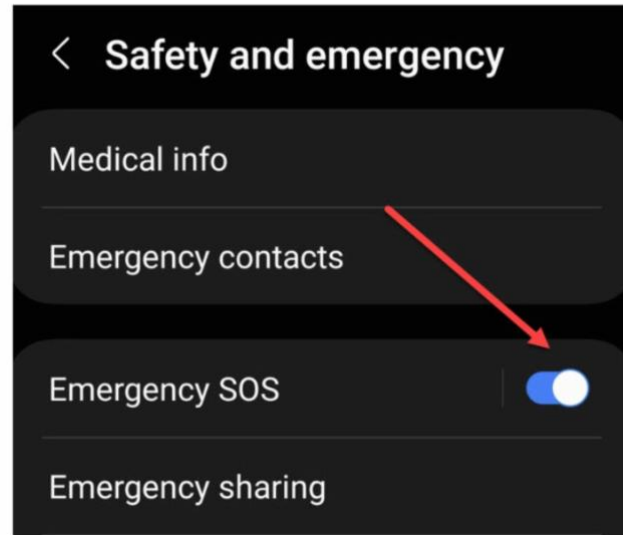
