



RECALL WARNING: METAL POWER BAR SOLD AT MAJOR RETAIL STORES ACROSS CANADA

Health Canada is warning shoppers about a major recall involving a popular product that can pose the risk of electrical shock. The recall is for the Mastercraft 8-Outlet Metal Power Bar, 4 foot (1.2 metres). The recalled product number is 052-9632. This recall includes all units manufactured prior to and including October 2020, Health Canada said in its recall warning.

The affected power bars will either have a 4-digit or a 6-digit Manufacturing Date Code. For the 4-digit date code, the first two digits are the month, the last two digits are the year. For the 6-digit date codes, the first two digits are the month, the last four digits are the year. The date codes can be found on the packaging near the barcode and on the back of the unit, Health Canada said.



"The black plastic caps covering the receptacles can come off when unplugging a cord from the unit, exposing the internal components and posing a risk of electric shock to the consumer," Health Canada said in identifying the hazard. *"Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled products and return them to any Canadian Tire store for a full refund,"* the notice states.

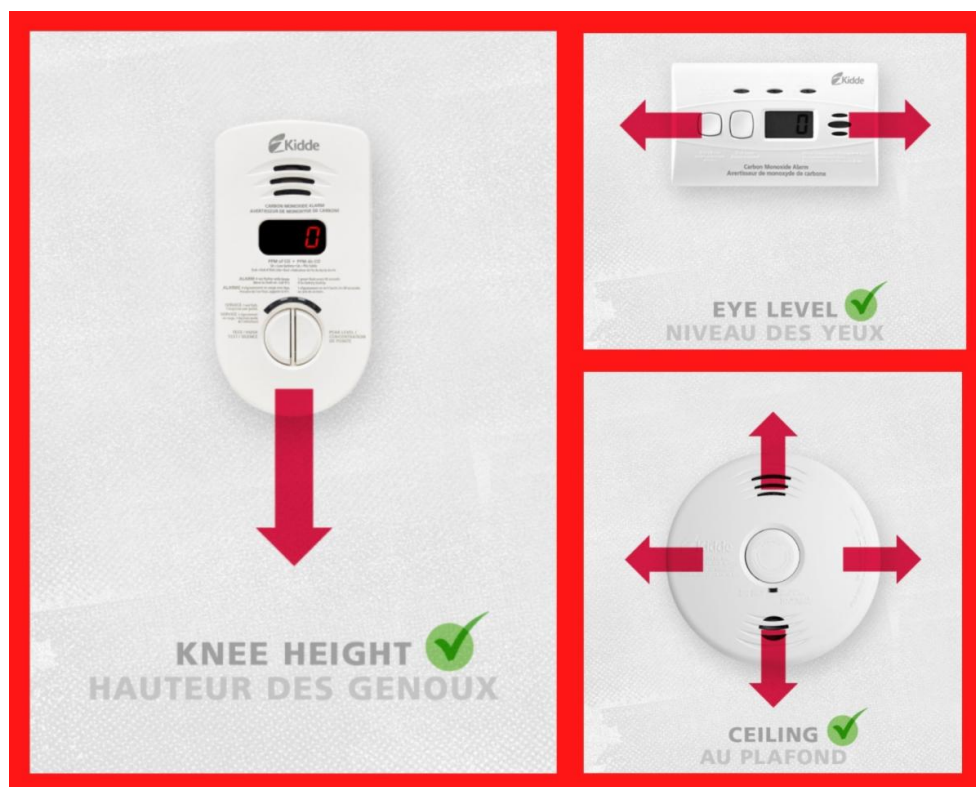


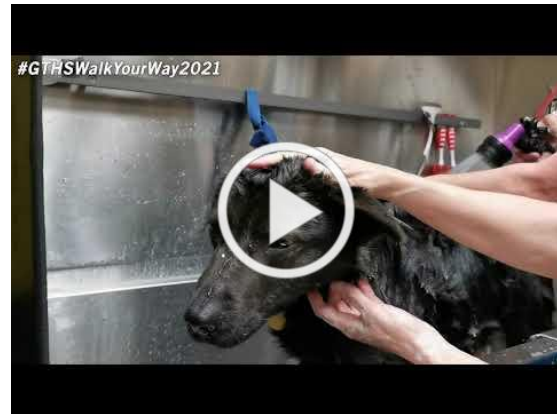
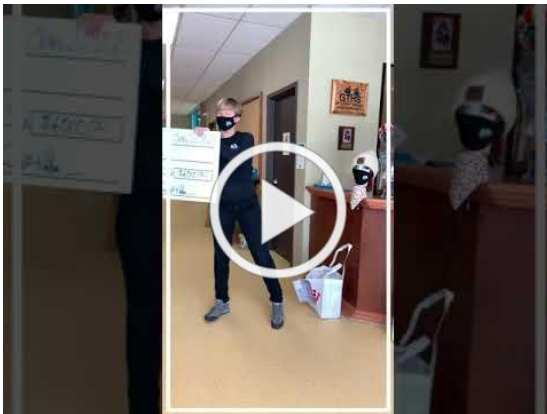

SECURITY CAMERA PROGRAM OFFERS REBATES FOR RESIDENTS & BUSINESSES IN ORILLIA

The Orillia Police Services Board recently approved a new system of surveillance that includes a security camera registry and mapping (SCRAM) program. It is designed to replace the existing downtown surveillance camera system and allow for expansion of security cameras and monitoring across the city. This program is also intended to help deter crime and assist law enforcement with investigations by decreasing the length of time it currently takes for police officers to canvas areas in the downtown.

There is a rebate program currently accepting applications on a first-come-first-serve basis for residents and businesses that purchase and install security camera systems on their property

and register them using the SCRAM Program. According to the City of Orillia website, "the program provides a rebate of up to 50% of the value of the installed security camera system to a maximum of \$500 per property address. The rebate is exclusively for the cost of the camera(s) and does not include installation, additional storage, repairs, accessories or any cameras that are purchased but not installed on the exterior of the building. Camera systems must be purchased/installed on the building after April 1, 2021, and before all available funds are expended. Any costs that are incurred either before the start of the project period or after the expiration of the project period are not permissible."

Monitoring Station Operator

Monitoring Station Operators will be based in either our Midland or Muskoka 24/7 ULC listed monitoring stations. Operators will need to identify the different types of signals and the Standard Operating Procedures to deal with each signal. Successful candidates will also be required to be proficient in the verification and dispatching of alarms, compliance with departmental standards for call processing and customer service goals, be able to perform basic troubleshooting on monitored systems (escalating as necessary to appropriate support departments as per policies and procedures), complete call logs and produce call reports, route calls to appropriate resources within the company, process data changes to customer accounts, keep equipment operational by following established procedures; reporting malfunctions and attend meetings/training as required.

This position requires flexibility as shift work is involved, days, evenings, nights, weekends and holidays.

Security Alarm Technician

The Security Alarm Technician will be responsible for the installation, rough-ins and pre-wiring of structured cabling, burglar alarm detection systems, door/access control systems, public address/intercom systems, CCTV/IP camera systems, control & display systems, networks, audio/video and associated structured cabling termination and audio components. Troubleshooting, commissioning and maintenance activities will also be required.

This position also requires that the individual attend to on-call emergency calls as required as part of the on-call rotation for emergency after-hours service and customer service.

Fire Safety Manager

The fire safety manager will be a consummate professional with supervisory experience, have the ability and knowledge to sell all fire safety products and manage technicians/sales representatives of the Fire Safety Division (the FSD). The fire safety manager will manage the full cycle of the FSD, which includes all areas relating to fire safety technicians and fire safety sales representatives.
