Ongoing training and (re)certification are an important part of our commitment to improving the customer experience and staying current with changes in industry regulations.


Recently Chris Mazur, James Boileau and Taylor Lalonde have completed

# HARDWIRED KIDDE NIGHTHAWK SMOKE DETECTOR AND CARBON MONOXIDE ALARMS RECALLED

There has been a national recall of 1.5 million Kidde NightHawk smoke detectors and carbon monoxide alarms - specifically the KN-COSM-IBCA and KN-COSM-ICA models that were manufactured between June 2004 and March 2011. The issue is that they may not "chirp" to alert home owners that there is an emergency. The model number is located on the back of the devices as shown below.
