CAMSAFE PROGRAM: OPP ENCOURAGING RESIDENTS TO HELP FIGHT CRIME IN THEIR COMMUNITY

Some local communities in our area, including Alliston, Hanover, Tiny Township and Nottawasaga, have joined a community-based security video registry program called

Camsafe. This voluntary network of residential (and some business and commercial) CCTV and security cameras is helping the OPP expedite investigation procedures and solve crime.

"Think of it like Neighbourhood Watch 2.0. The program is set up to be a registry of anyone who owns security cameras, CCTV systems or doorbell cams in the province of Ontario. Only police have access to the database of registrants. Camsafe only requests basic contact information and camera locations – nothing else. No account information or specifics required. And you can change or delete your information at any time. All this program is aimed at doing is providing a starting point for police officers to find video footage to assist an investigation. For example, if there was a break and enter to a home on a city street, the investigating officer can log onto Camsafe and much like Google Maps, geofence an area and see if there are anyone who has registered a camera in the area. From that point, the officer – using the contact information provided – would request the footage from the owner."

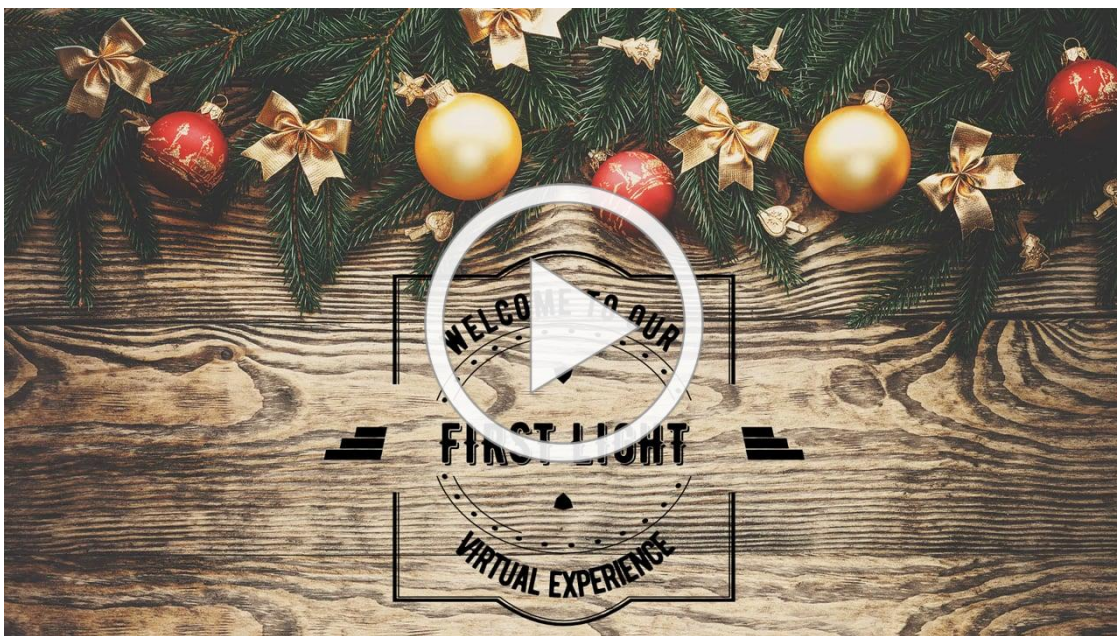
