- Please test your smoke alarms to be sure they are working and install new batteries every year or more frequently as required.
- We recommend installing smoke alarms with a 10 year battery life.
- Consider installing a monitored smoke alarm that will automatically transmit a fire condition from your home to our <u>24 hour ULC Listed monitoring station</u>.
- Make sure everyone in the home knows the sound of the smoke alarm.
